



MAC 172 210 400 Specific use based requirements	
WAC 173-219-400 Specific use-based requirements	

#### Feasibility analysis

- Clarified requirement for existing facilities.
- Clarified the planning period to be 20 years.
- Added references to other planning documents that may be use to meet all or part of the submittal requirements.
- Removed some of the excess details and will move to purple book.
- Created separate subsection for private utility capacity assessment.

#### **Certified operators**

Created standalone section.

• Flexibility in allowable certifications, including:

• Possible reclaimed water certification in the future.

#### Use agreements

- Changed from 'generator agreement' to 'use agreement'.
- Eliminated most of the details.
- Retained condition for lead agency review and approval with mention of minimum requirements.

#### **Cross-connection control (CCC)**

- Expanded considerably.
  - Minimum required elements of CCC program.
  - Backflow prevention.
  - Record keeping and reporting.

#### **Disinfection process standards**

- Clarified that a 4-log virus removal or inactivation is required for all Class A reclaimed water.
- Clarified that when chlorine is used as disinfectant it must be measured as 'free chlorine'.
- Clean up the Validation of virus removal, including allowing for 3<sup>rd</sup> party validation studies.

# Storage and distribution system requirements


- Clearly requiring 200 feet separation distance from potable supply intakes.
- Consolidated two sections into one.
- Removed redundancies.

#### Specific use-based standards

- Changed receiving environment headings to be more precise.
- Removed the reference to potable / nonpotable for groundwater and surface water uses.
- Combined all release for surface water augmentation into one use category.
- Provided consistency between Table 2 and definitions and terms used throughout rule.




