Dear Mr. Robbins

The Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) finds that contractors may use the Rubberform Trackout Mat construction entrance mats as a temporary erosion control mechanism. These mats must adhere to the guidelines of BMP C105: Stabilized Construction Entrance, found in Volume II of the Stormwater Management Manual for Western Washington or BMP C105E as found in Chapter 7 of the Stormwater Management Manual for Eastern Washington. The design requirements should adhere to the minimum length and width requirements of BMP C105. Follow manufacturer guidelines for installation.

Contractors may use Rubberform Trackout Mat construction entrance mats at project sites without seeking additional Ecology approval. However, Ecology cannot endorse this product or its manufacturer.
