<b>Purpose:</b> Ecology is adopting the fifth emergency rule – Chapter 173-443 WAC, Hydrofluorocarbons (HFCs) – to establish requirements to reduce greenhouse gases in Washington by moving to the phased use of less damaging HFCs or acceptable substitutes.
The emergency rule requires manufacturers, importers, and distributors to notify Ecology about their products and equipment containing HFCs and other substitutes. The initial deadline was December 31, 2019. More notifications are due when new restrictions apply between 2020 and 2024.
We changed the restriction deadline for vending machines from January 1, 2020, to January 1, 2022, in the first emergency rule. We continue to adopt the 2022 date because we determined that the new date reduces the overall risk to human health or the environment. It also reflects the earliest date that a lower risk substitute is potentially available as allowed by RCW 70A.45.080 (3)(a).
The emergency rule will be in effect for up to 120 days starting October 20, 2020, replacing the one adopted on June 25, 2020. The rule will expire when the permanent rule, Chapter 173-443 WAC, becomes effective.
We updated the rule to reflect the new chapter number of the law as directed by legislation in 2020.
