What we're doing and why

- Ecology is developing a rule for grants & loans we issue that:
 - Are funded by the Model Toxics Control Act (MTCA funded).
 - Aren't already covered by a specific grant or loan program rule.

RCW
 70.105D.070(8)
 directs Ecology to
 adopt rules "for
 grant or loan
 issuance and
 performance" which
 applies to all MTCA
 funded grants or
 loans.



Our goal

Put existing best practices into rule to meet legal obligations for MTCA funded grant and loan programs.



The draft new rule:

- Allows us to administer funds clearly and consistently.
- Reflects how grants and loans are currently managed.
- Provides clarity on requirements related to issuance and performance.
- All new agreements, signed after the effective date of the rule (31 days after adoption), must be managed in Ecology's electronic system.
