consistent with existing practice. As a result, we are revising the language in WAC 173-323-110(3) to match
current Ecology policy language. The additions to the language are underlined and the deletions have strikethrough
text.

state, federal, or other sources is withdrawn, reduced, or limited in any way after the agreement effective date and
