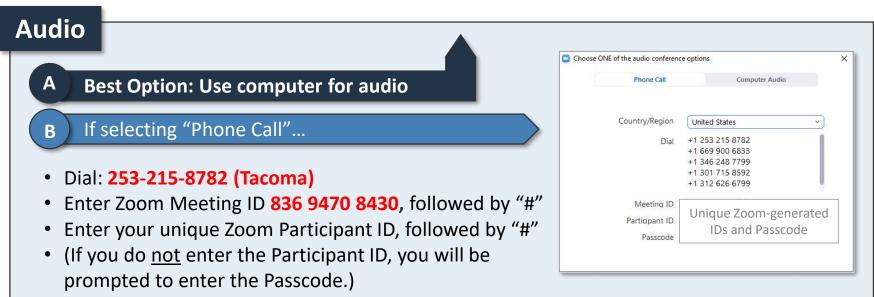
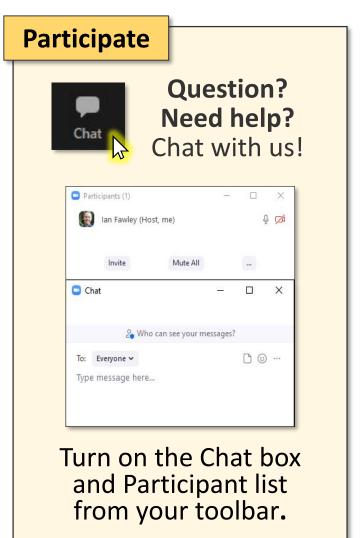

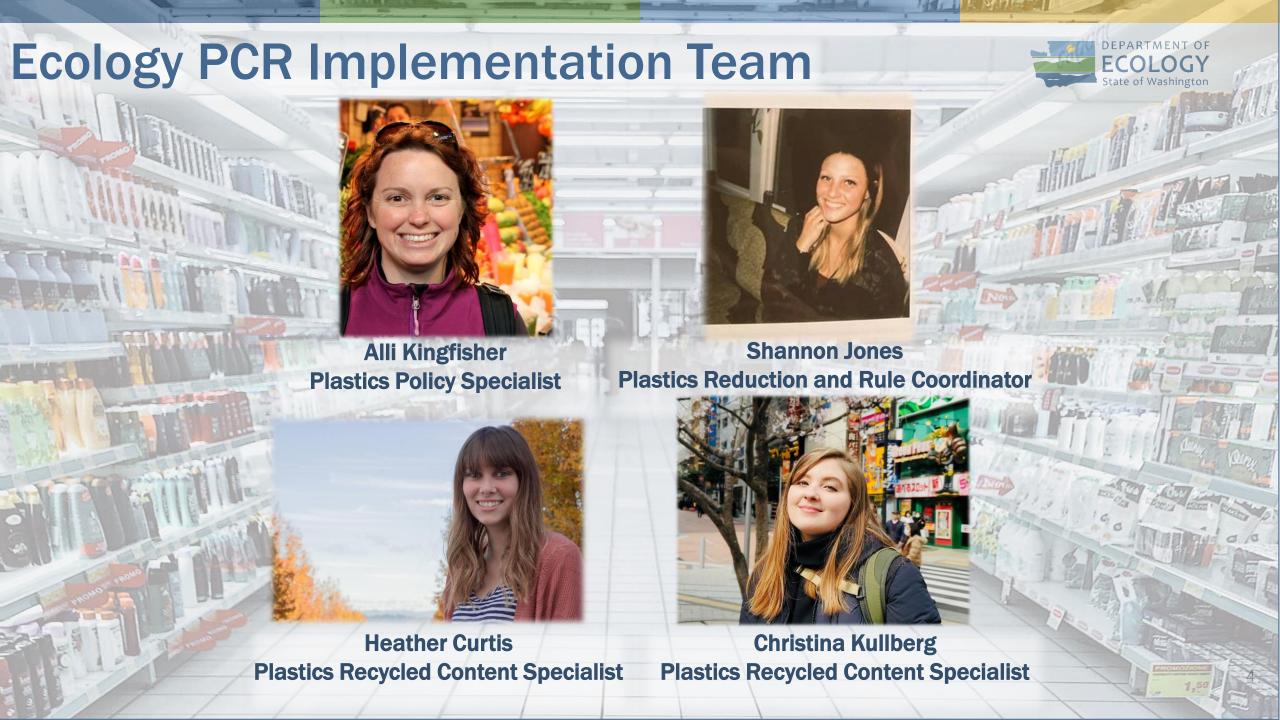

Part B - Fees

- Key Changes since last draft:
 - "Other criteria for equitable distribution" removed
 - Fee handling for late registrations
 - Underlined the importance of accurate registration/reporting
 - Clarity on follow-up actions for delinquent payment, including use of a collection agency
 - Updates to equation variables, based on the updated terms to distinguish covered products and PCRC products.

Fee Distribution



CY 2022 based on current registration data

Equation 1(a), Program Administration Fee

Program Administration Fee = Ecology Program Administration Cost x [(Individual Producer Resins, Covered Products)/
(Washington Resin Totals, Covered Products)]

Admin Fee = \$603,144 X [(One Producer's Total Resin Weight)/201,914,558 lbs total]

Fee Adjustments

- Factors for which fees may be adjusted:
 - Difference between actual revenue and costs for the most recent prior closed fiscal year.
 - Late registration and reporting data.
 - Revised resin weight

- Timeline for submitting documentation for excluded product packaging

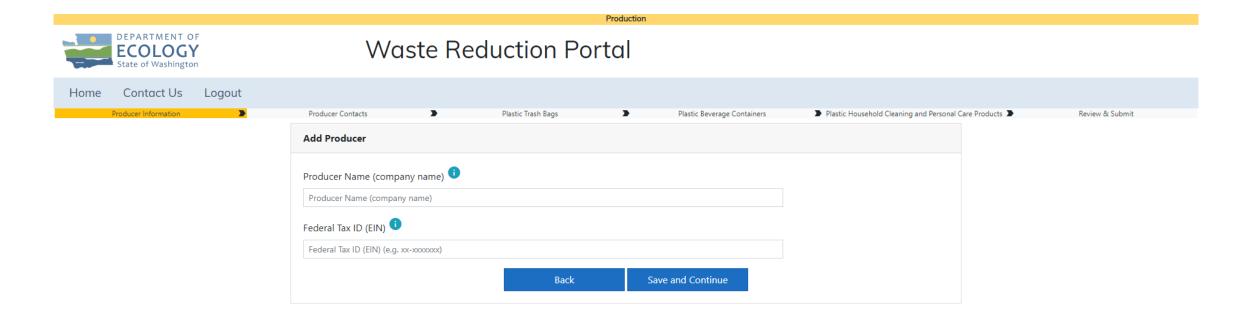


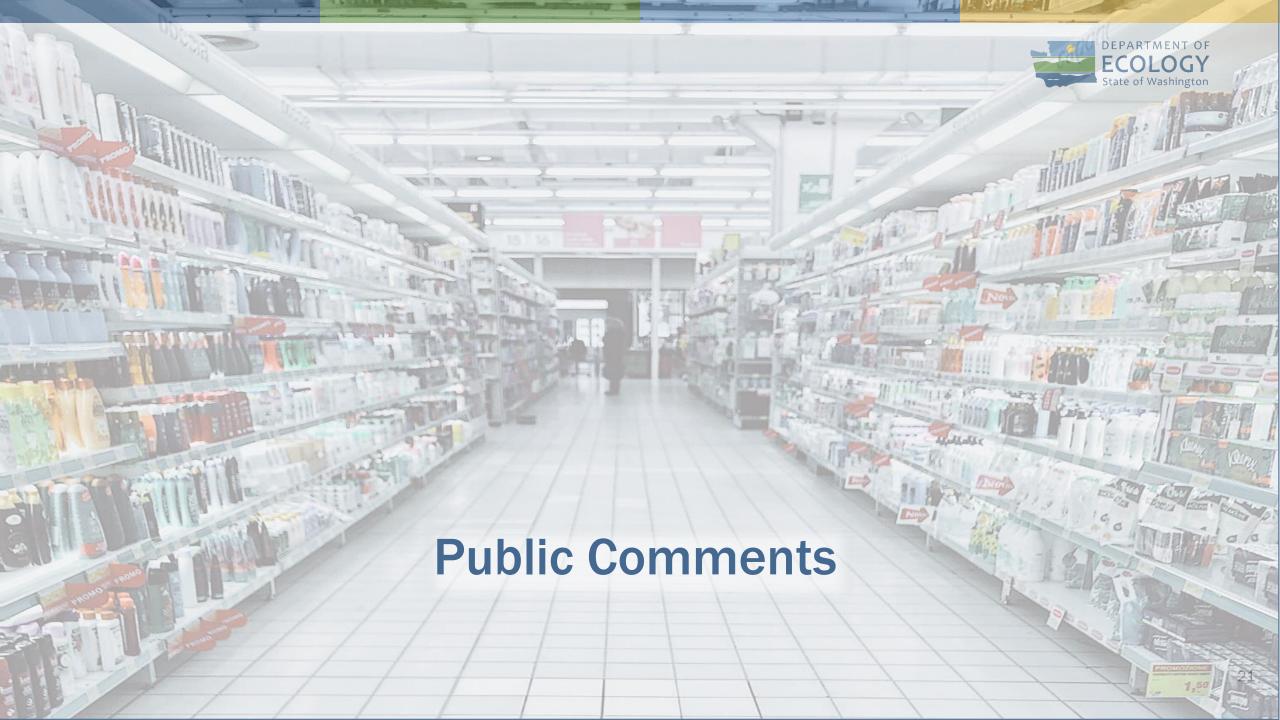
Part D - Enforcement

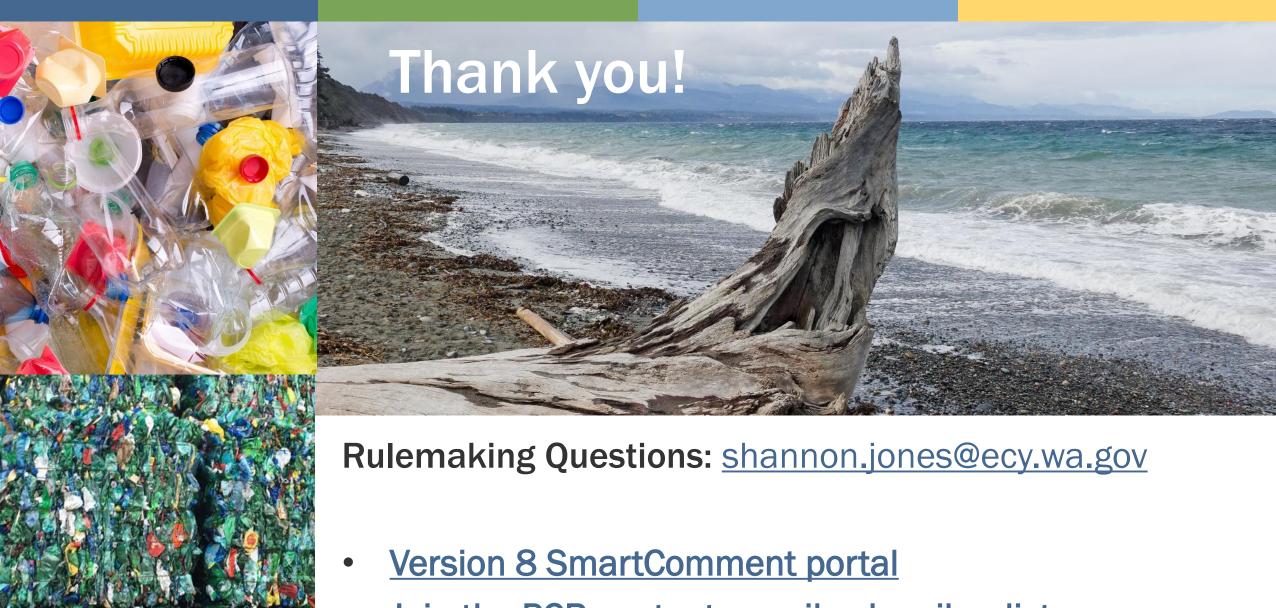
