## PUBLIC COMMENTS SUMMARY

- Still treating reclaimed water like wastewater
- Clarify the Distributor and User/Uses roles and responsibilities – *Use Management Plan*
- Clarify Generator's required 'capacities', including roles and responsibilities
- Clarify how to add new Uses
- Clarify Water Rights Impairment Definition and analysis process
- Reassure water rights protection, including reserved rights and instream flows
- Clarify how addressing Emerging Contaminants of Concern
- Simplify the engineering report requirements – including reporting requirements

## SUGGESTED PATHWAY FORWARD

- November 30 RAC Workshop
- January – March 2016 Regions meet with Commenters in small groups to clarify comments
- May-June 2016 RAC meetings to review and discuss new proposed rule
- July-August Prepare CR-102 for Public Process and implement process to update the Purple Book
