 Distinction between pervious and impervious surfaces in the drainage area that could affect the percolation of stormwater runoff into the ground (e.g., asphalt, crushed rock, grass).
- **3.** <u>From Page 54</u>: This change is a minor modification per 40 CFR 122.63(a). *Pressure washing* means the use of a water pressure washer to remove paint, grime, or biological growth from the hull of a vessel. Pressure washing also includes the practice of mechanical or hand scrubbing and rinsing. with low-pressure water from a hose.
- **4.** From Page 59: This change is a minor modification per 40 CFR 122.63(a). *Visual monitoring* means an inspection by the Permittee of the permitted facility to determine, to the extent that can be determined visually, that BMPs are in place and effective at controlling pollutants in stormwater runoff. Visual monitoring includes observations to detect the presence of an oil sheen in stormwater runoff. Visual monitoring inspections are logged and reported on the discharge monitoring report.
