Dear Ms. Jackels:

On July 20, 2017, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Seattle District submitted a Certification of Consistency with the Washington State Coastal Zone Management Program (CZMP). On August 28, 2017, the review period was extended to November 15, 2017.

This determination is for the Westhaven Cove Small Boat Basin dredge maintenance dredging of up to 75,000 cubic yards of sediment per dredge event over a ten-year period (2018-2027) to maintain the authorized depths within the Westhaven Cove Small Boat Basin navigational channel. This includes the Northwest Entrance Channel, Southeast Entrance Channel, an Access Channel, and a Turning Basin. The maximum dredge depth is 18 feet below Mean Lower Low Water (MLLW). Dredge material suitable for in water disposal (maximum 75,000 cubic yards per dredge event) will be placed at either the South Jetty or Point Chehalis dispersive sites via a mechanical clamshell dredge.

Pursuant to Section 307(c)(3) of the Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972 as amended, Ecology concurs with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Seattle District determination that the proposed work is consistent with Washington's CZMP.

**YOUR RIGHT TO APPEAL**

You have a right to appeal this Order to the Pollution Control Hearing Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt of this Order. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).

To appeal you must do all of the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this decision:


- File your appeal and a copy of this Order with the PCHB (see addresses below). Filing means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours.
- Serve a copy of your appeal and this Order on Ecology in paper form - by mail or in person. (See addresses below.) E-mail is not accepted.

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.
