North Bridge Replacement Project, Lake Union, Seattle, King County, Washington**

Dear Ms. Yim:

On January 24, 2017, you submitted a Certification of Consistency with the Washington State Coastal Zone Management Program (CZMP) for the Fairview Avenue North Bridge Replacement project. On July 17, 2017, Seattle Department of Transportation and Ecology agreed to stay the CZM until January 24, 2018.

The proposed project entails replacement of the Fairview Avenue North Bridge with a single multi-span bridge.

The project is located at Fairview Avenue North, Seattle, King County, Washington, Lake Union, Section 29, T. 25 N., R. 4E., WRIA 8.

Pursuant to Section 307(c)(3) of the Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972 as amended, Ecology concurs with your determination that the proposed work is consistent with Washington's CZMP.

YOUR RIGHT TO APPEAL

You have a right to appeal this consistency determination to the Pollution Control Hearings Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt of this consistency determination. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).

To appeal you must do all of the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this consistency determination:

- File your appeal and a copy of this consistency determination with the PCHB (see addresses below). Filing means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours.



- Serve a copy of your appeal and this consistency determination on Ecology in paper form - by mail or in person. (See addresses below.) E-mail is not accepted.

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.
