Project Description: Place fill material in 0.45 acre of wetlands to expand lumber treatment, storage, and shipping facilities. Approximately 1.82 acres of wetland would be enhanced as mitigation, along with establishing buffers on the north and south sides of the mitigation site.

Project Location: Northwest of the intersection of Bob Mitchell Avenue and Front Street, Wetlands, Sumas, Whatcom County, Washington.
