Project Name: Wahkiakum County Multiple Site 10-Year Sand Placement Program

Applicant: Wahkiakum County Public Works

Project Location: The work will be located at adjoining properties at three separate sites along the Shoreline of Puget Island and one site near Cape Horn, in the Columbia River near Cathlamet, Wahkiakum County, Washington.

Project Description: Place up to 2,182,080 million cubic yards of clean dredged material (sand) on 104 acres over a period of 10 years to protect private property.
