**ORDINANCE NO. 539**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NAPAVINE, WASHINGTON, AMENDING PORTIONS OF ORDINANCE 464 ( CRITICAL AREAS ORDINANCE) AS DESCRIBED ON PAGES 39 THROUGH 42 OF THE JULY 2014 CITY OF NAPAVINE SHORELINE MASTER PROGRAM UPDATE, APPROVING THE JULY 2014 CITY OF NAPAVINE SHORELINE MASTER PROGRAM UPDATE AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, the State of Washington requires periodic updates of the City's Shoreline Master Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the current Critical Areas Ordinance was codified by Ordinance 464 on December 22, 2009; and

**WHEREAS**, the City's Shoreline Master Program and Critical Areas Ordinance needed to be amended to meet the new changes to the Shoreline Management Act; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Napavine obtained state funding under Grant #G1200045; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Napavine formed a Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC) and held a Planning Commission meeting with the CAC on May 21, 2013; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Napavine held a Public meeting/open house to discuss shorelines on June 18, 2013; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Napavine submitted a draft Shoreline master Program Update to the Department of Ecology on December 26, 2013; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Napavine held additional Planning Commission meetings to discuss the Shoreline Master Program with the CAC on February 10, 2014 and May 20 2014; and

**WHEREAS**, the environmental review was performed under the State Environmental Policy Act with a determination of non-significance issued on June 18, 2014; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Napavine conducted an open house on June 24, 2014; and

**WHEREAS**, the 60-day notice was sent October 27, 2014, to the Washington State Department of Commerce informing it of the proposed change in development regulations; and

**WHEREAS**, the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) requested a minor change on page 84 of the July 2014 Shoreline Master Program update on December 2, 2014; and

**WHEREAS**, the City's consultant corrected, reissued and obtained approval of the July 2014 Shoreline Master Program update with the amended page 84 from WSDOT on January 6, 2014; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council met March 24, 2015, discussed the proposed SMP which was modified in response to previous WSDOT comments, and recommended approval;

NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NAPAVINE, WASHINGTON,  
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


**Section 1.** Adoption. The attached Shoreline Master Program referenced as Exhibit A is hereby adopted.

**Section 2.** Effective Date. This ordinance or a summary thereof consisting of the title shall be published in the official newspaper of the City, and shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon approval by the Washington State Department of Ecology (DOE).
