RESOLUTION NO. 656

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF GOLDENDALE, WASHINGTON,
EXPRESSING INTENT TO ADOPT ON UPDATE TO THE SHORELINE MASTER
PROGRAM AS ATTACHED HERTO.**

WHEREAS, the State of Washington requires periodic updates of the city's Shoreline Master Program, and

WHEREAS, legislative changes were made to the Shoreline Management Act since the city's Shoreline Master Program was adopted, and

WHEREAS, the City of Goldendale obtained state funding under Grant #G1400611, and

WHEREAS, the City Council heard a brief introduction to the Shoreline Master Program at the November 3, 2014 council meeting,

WHEREAS, the City of Goldendale conducted a public open house on November 3, 2014, and

WHEREAS, the city Council held a work session on March 16, 2015, and

WHEREAS, the City of Goldendale conducted a second public open house on May 11, 2015, and

WHEREAS, the City Council heard an update on the Shoreline Master Program at the February 1, 2016 council meeting, and

WHEREAS, the City of Goldendale submitted drafts of the Shoreline Master Program to the Washington State Department of Ecology on May 12, 2015 and February 26, 2016, and

WHEREAS, the 60-day notice was sent March 22, 2016 to the Washington State Department of Commerce informing it of the proposed change in development regulations, and

WHEREAS, the environmental review was performed under the State Environmental Policy Act with a determination of non-significance issued March 25, 2016, and

WHEREAS, RCW 90.58.090 requires that proposed Shoreline Master Programs be reviewed and approved by the state prior to taking effect.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOLDENDALE, WASHINGTON AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. ADOPTION. The City Council hereby adopts the following attached Shoreline Master Program, together with appendices A and B.

Section 2. COPY TO DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE. Pursuant to RCW 36-70A3106, the City Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to provide a copy of this resolution to the Washington State Department of Commerce within 10 days of adoption.


Section 3. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of the Shoreline Master Program, or its application to any person or legal entity or circumstances, is held invalid, the remainder of the Shoreline Master Program, or the application of the provision to other persons or legal entities or circumstances, shall not be affected.

Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. The City's Shoreline Master Program and all amendments thereto shall become effective 14 days from the date of Ecology's written notice of final approval.
