**RE: Tigerfloc used with BMP C250 for Construction Stormwater Chemical Treatment**

Dear Mr. Cartelier:

The Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) finds that Tigerfloc is functionally equivalent to the flocculent chemicals identified in BMP C250 Construction Stormwater Chemical Treatment. Contractors may use Tigerfloc as a replacement for other approved chemicals such as ChitoSan Acetate when operating an enhanced sand filtration system on construction sites.

Ecology will place this letter under Tigerfloc on its website.
