 - For three years after its last sale or distribution.
 - This certificate must be provided if requested.
- Our food packaging or packaging component is in compliance with WA State RCW 70A.222.070 as described in [Ecology's First Alternatives Assessment](#).
- Attached to this certification is a list of all products included in this certification, including product names and/or identifying features.
 - (optional) Attached to this certification is documentation that the packaging or packaging components do not contain any intentionally added PFAS chemicals.
- Our food packaging or packaging component is exempt from compliance with WA State RCW 70A.222.070 as described in RCW 70A.222.030(1)(2).
- Attached to this certification is documentation that the packaging or packaging components meet the criteria defined in RCW 70A.222.030(1) or RCW 70A.222.030(2).
- Food packaging manufactured by our company is not sold in Washington State.
