NOTICE OF 30-DAY PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD FOR A PROPOSED AIR POLLUTION SOURCE

The Washington State Department of Corrections (DOC) manages a medium security prison with a minimum security camp in Connell. The facility, called the Coyote Ridge Corrections Center, has a street address of 1301 North Ephrata Ave, Connell, WA, 99326. In 2017, DOC applied to Ecology to replace an obsolete emergency generator (Detroit Diesel 750 kW) with a new engine (800 kW Caterpillar C 27). In the event of a primary power failure, the prison's emergency engines provide power to a variety of end uses. Ecology has determined that DOC has satisfied the requirements of New Source Review in WAC 173-400-113 and the toxics requirements of WAC 173-460. Ecology expects to approve this project, and the public is invited to comment. A public hearing will be held if Ecology determines there is significant public interest.
