Reasons supporting proposal: RCW 90.48.465 requires Ecology to establish, by rule, annual permit fees to recover the cost of administering the wastewater and stormwater permit programs. Ecology adopted Chapter 173-224 WAC – Water Quality Permit Fees in response to this law in 1999. This proposed rule amendment allows Ecology to continue recovering expenses in operating and managing the permit programs. Given the unprecedented changes to our state and the economy during the pandemic, Ecology is proposing to maintain permit fees at their current rate for the next two years. Ecology is also proposing a new permit fee category for the Puget Sound Nutrient General Permit, changes to the structure of the Vessel Deconstruction permit fee category, and
