



2025-2027 Wood Stove Recycle Award Instructions FOR HOUSEHOLD APPLICANT USE ONLY

Program ends June 30, 2027, or until funding runs out (whichever is first).

Program Qualifications

1. Must have an **uncertified** wood stove that is **NOT** compliant with [EPA-Certified Wood Stove Database](#).¹
2. Applicant **must** reside in one of these zip codes to qualify: **98824, 98848, 99301, 99321, 99323, 99330, 99343, 99344, 99349, 99357, or 99363.**
3. Wood stove must have been installed and used in home from one of the qualifying zip codes. **Strict limit of 2 wood stoves per household/applicant.**
4. Wood stove must be in working order to be eligible for the \$500 recycle award.
 - a. **Not eligible for recycle award:** Outside stove (camp, barrel, homemade, fire pit, chiminea) or pellet stove

Applicant Instructions

1. **Complete one application form for each wood stove to recycle. Strict limit of 2 wood stoves per household/applicant.**
2. Provide required photos: Front of the wood stove, back of the wood stove, and readable placard certification and/or manufacturer's information tag (if applicable). Provide clear photos. Ecology must be able to read certification and manufacturer's information in photos.
3. Submit completed application and photos to Ecology.

4. Applicants will be notified of acceptance or denial by either email or mail. After being notified of acceptance, proceed with the following:
 - a. Call Pacific Steel & Recycling (509-582-2134) for hours of operation and delivery instructions.
 - b. Applicants should bring the following to Pacific Steel & Recycling
 - i. Destruction Certificate, provided by Ecology upon acceptance
 - ii. Wood stove for destruction
 - Stove should be cleaned out of firebricks, ash, and debris.
 - c. Deliver the wood stove and make sure Pacific Steel & Recycling completes the Destruction Certificate. Pacific Steel will return the completed certificate to Ecology.
 - d. Once Ecology receives confirmation from Pacific Steel that the stove was processed, Ecology will send the applicant an invoice (A-19 form) to complete and return to Ecology to process for payment.
 - e. Once Ecology receives the completed A-19 invoice, Ecology will issue a check to the applicant and mail it to the address provided on the A-19 invoice. **Allow a minimum of 4 weeks for payment processing.**
