The Pierce County Environmental Official reviewed the proposed Shoreline Master Program in September 2012 according to the requirements of the State's Environmental Policy Act (SEPA). That review resulted in the issuance of a Determination of Nonsignificance and the adoption of existing documents.

As the Council begins the final adoption of the Master Program an additional review has been done of the amendments passed by the Community Development Committee.

None of the amendments would allow actions that would cause "probable significant adverse environmental impacts" and thus the original SEPA determination is still valid.
