

# Underground Storage Tank Regulations Chapter 173-360A WAC Adopted Rule

Crosswalk with Repealed Rule and Federal Rule

July 18, 2018

#### Purpose of this document:

On July 18, 2018, the Department of Ecology (Ecology) repealed existing Chapter 173-360 WAC and adopted new Chapter 173-360A WAC, Underground Storage Tank (UST) Regulations. The new chapter modifies and replaces the repealed chapter. This document provides a crosswalk between the provisions in the new rule and the provisions in both the repealed rule and the federal rule.
