**Agency:** Department of Ecology AO# 24-12

**Subject of possible rule making:** Department of Ecology is considering amendments to sections under Chapter 173-350 WAC. This rulemaking will focus on amendments and new language related to organic materials management. These amendments will consider standards to address contamination in organic waste and finished products such as compost. Ecology is also considering amendments that cover additional organic materials management practices.

**Statutes authorizing the agency to adopt rules on this subject:** RCW 70A.205.275 Rules—Department "deferring" to other permits—Application of section, RCW 70A.205.210 Duties of department—State solid waste management plan—Assistance—Coordination—Tire recycling

**Reasons why rules on this subject may be needed and what they might accomplish:** Ecology must amend its organic materials management regulations to address contamination in incoming food waste feedstocks and finished products at organic materials processing facilities, as required by RCW 70A.205.540. We will address current inequities and existing challenges in meeting requirements.

**Identify other federal and state agencies that regulate this subject and the process coordinating the rule with these agencies:** Washington Department of Agriculture, which has authority under RCW 15.135.080 to adopt rules that regulate agriculture in Washington. The US Environmental Protection Agency, which has authority to ensure clean air, water, and land.
