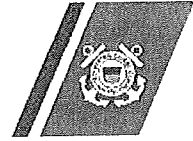

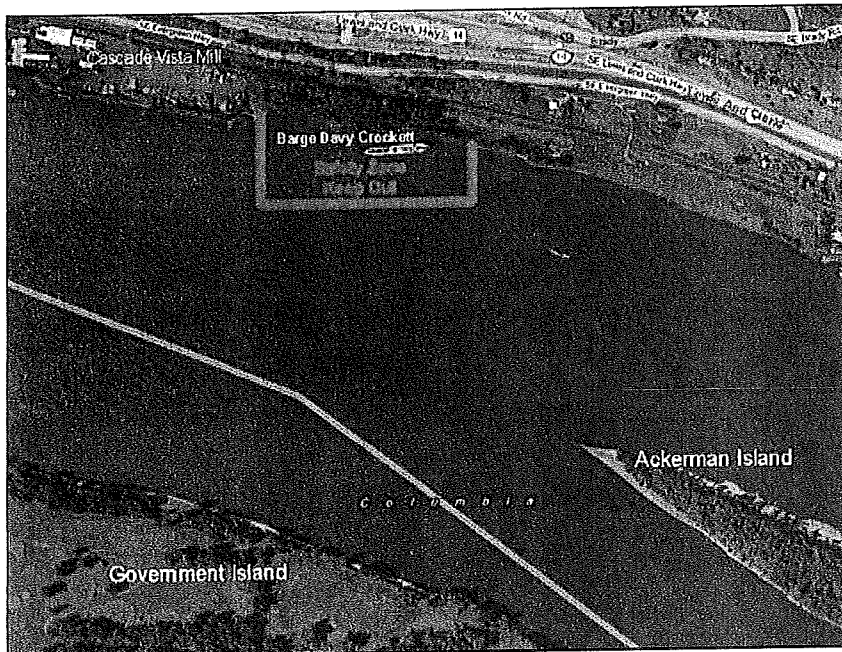

News Release: Coast Guard diminishes size of Safety Zone around Davy Crockett



Location of Davy Crockett: Latitude 45 34 56.7 North / Longitude 122 28 20.5 West

PORTLAND, Ore. —The Coast Guard diminished the size of the safety zone around the site of operations aboard the barge Davy Crockett Friday.

The safety zone extends 200 feet in all directions from the outermost points of the operation, to include boom and support vessels. There is no wake while transiting this area. The safety zone is in effect for both stationary and transiting operations.

Boaters are asked to observe all posted signs.
