

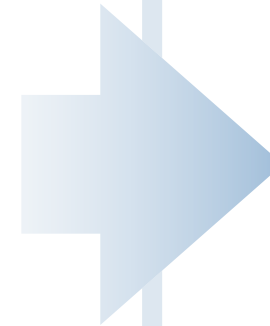
# Olympic Pipeline Spill in Conway, WA – Cleanup Phases

## Emergency Response

- Cleaning up the spilled gasoline while minimizing environmental harm and ensuring the safety of the community and response workers
- Led by a unified command

## Restoration

- Assess soil and groundwater for contamination (oversight by Ecology's Toxics Cleanup Program)
- Develop and implement plan for cleanup of any residual contamination and long-term monitoring
- Restore and replant spill impact area



**Dec. 10, 2023**

Spill occurs. Leak is detected and stopped. Cleanup begins, including excavation of contaminated soil from farmland

**January 2024**

Excavation of contaminated soil continues from farmland to riparian area, including stream bank removal

**Late Winter/Early Spring 2024**

Excavation of contaminated soil and sediment complete

**Spring 2024**

Cleanup process under state's Model Toxics Control Act begins

## Investigation

- Determine the underlying causes of the spill
- Conducted separately from emergency response
- Separate investigations by bp, Washington State Utilities & Transportation Commission, Ecology
