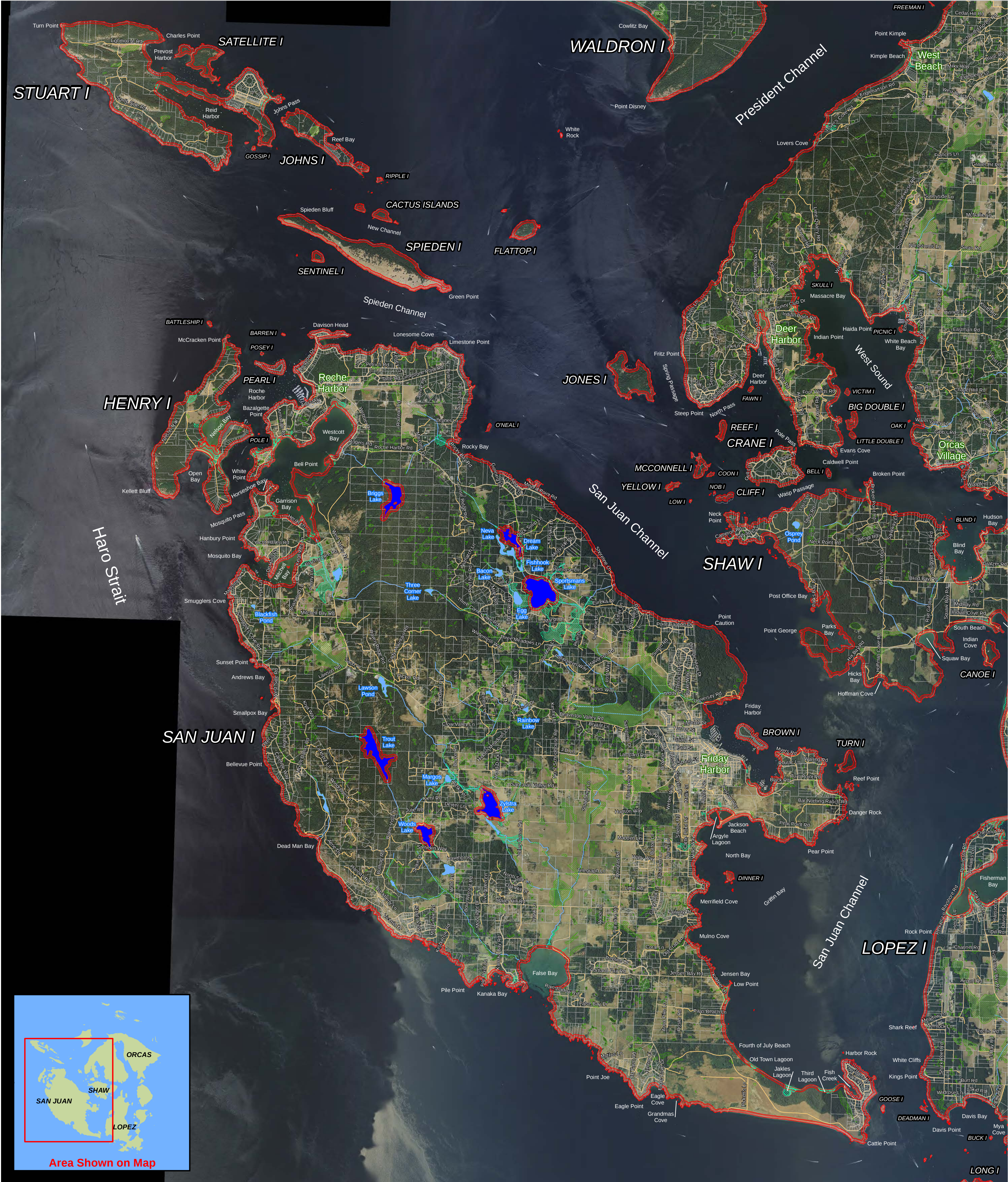


Map 2A:

San Juan County Shoreline Master Program Update



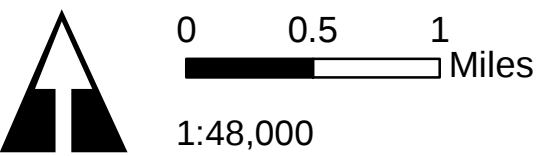

Note 3: All small islands, rocks, and reefs that are not shown on this map are included in shoreline jurisdiction.



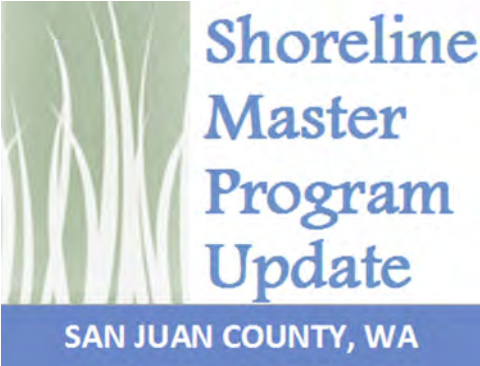
