



#### Improved

- Exemptions
- Reporting
- Penalty forgiveness

#### New


- Process for setting emission limit higher than standard in the SIP
- Alternative opacity standard



## **Alternative Opacity Standard**

- Soot blowing and grate cleaning
- Startup or shutdown of hog fuel or wood-fired boiler
- Startup of lime kiln/industrial furnace/boiler to cure furnace refractory

### **Public Notice Changes**



#### **Public Comment Period**

- 30-day minimum
- Does not include Washington holidays
- Must post on internet by noon to count as first day
- Permit Register
