**Purpose:** The Department of Ecology (Ecology) is adopting amendments to Chapter173-360A WAC, Underground Storage Tank (UST) Regulations. The regulations govern the installation, operation, maintenance, and closure of UST systems containing petroleum or other regulated substances. The regulations also govern the detection of, responses to, and financial responsibility for release from those systems. This rulemaking is limited to the financial responsibility requirements for UST releases in Part 10 of Chapter 173-360A WAC.

Ecology is adopting amendments to proposes to amend chapter 173-360A WAC, Underground Storage Tank (UST) Regulations, to allow use of a state fund or other state assurance program to demonstrate financial responsibility for cleaning up UST releases and compensating third parties for bodily injury and property damage caused by the releases.
