Approximate Funding Amounts & Application Dates

- \$14 Million
 - Scrap and replace diesel school buses with zero emission
- Application window
 - Opens November 16, 2023
 - Closes January 25, 2024
- Award pre-announcement first quarter 2024

- *Important* Read carefully before completing the application.

Eligible Applicants

School bus owners that transport students to K-12 schools

- Overseen by the Washington Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI)
- School bus owners transporting to private schools are **not** eligible



Eligible Projects

- Scrap and replace diesel school buses with zero emission buses
- Buses must be:
 - Owned by the applicant
 - Operating in Washington for at least one year before November 15, 2023
- Includes charging infrastructure

Funding Levels

 Ecology will use Free Reduced Priced Lunch (FRPL) program percentages for the current school year to determine funding levels

Applicant's transportation to

Public, tribal, and charter schools

- Must submit FRPL percentage from:
 - OSPI **school district** information for the 2023-24 school year
 - Data provided by Ecology in the grant guideline document

Application Scoring and Ranking


Criteria	Maximum Points
Replace oldest, most polluting school buses	20
Reduce diesel emissions in overburdened communities highly impacted by criteria air pollution	100
Reduce diesel emissions for economically disadvantaged children	60

Clean Diesel EV School Bus Grants

Award Structure - Distribution

Applicants assigned to Educational Service District (ESD) where new EV bus will operate

- Step 1: Award one to each highest scoring applicants per ESD with a FRPL 95% or greater – or Rural Low Income LEA
- Step 2: Of the remaining applicants, award one to each of the highest scoring applicants per ESD, as funds allow
- Step 3: Then, of the remaining applicants, one award per applicant to the highest scoring applicants, as funds allow



Ecology's Administration of Grants & Loans (EAGL)



EAGL

- Full grant applications must be submitted through EAGL.
- Applicants are required to have Secure Access Washington (SAW) and EAGL accounts.
- EAGL can only be accessed through SAW.
- Applications, funded grant agreements, scope of work deliverables, and payment requests/progress reports are managed in EAGL.




