



Olympic Pipeline gasoline spill Update to Conway School Community

January 7, 2024

This note is intended to update the Conway School Community about spill response efforts and inform you of next steps. Unified Command appreciates your continued patience as we work to respond to the gasoline discharge, and we remain committed to keeping the public informed about our progress.

Traffic update:

- Crews will reopen SR 534 to two-way traffic by 6:00 am, Monday, January 8.
- Temporary closures may occur as flaggers help facilitate truck movement in and out of the response area.
- Conway Hill Road has returned to one-way westerly traffic.
- Response crews are using a shuttle service to and from the work zone to reduce congestion on SR 534.
- For the safety of work crews, please use caution while driving through the response area.

Important to note:

- Continuous air monitoring has shown no public health risk from gasoline fumes.
- Sampling of soils, sediments and water is ongoing.
- A claims number has been established by Olympic Pipeline. Please call 1-866-616-1558 to report any personal or property damage resulting from the spill.
