At the end of the adjudication, each legal water use will be documented by the issuance of a certificate describing the entitled water amount. The certificate will be recorded with the property, providing evidence of legal water use for future owners.

### The court claim forms have not been mailed yet.

The Washington Department of Ecology will send them via certified mail after they are approved by the court. In general, the forms will ask for the location of your water withdrawal or diversion; the location, timing, and purpose of the water used; and the amount and rate of water used.
