Change in Scope

Narrowed Scope

- <u>Only</u> covers resource-specific pathway (fully compatible with EIM & EDAM, partially compatible with Markets+)
- Additional rulemaking is required to address unspecified electricity in M+ and mitigate any emissions leakage

• What Doesn't Change

- Unified approach & terminology for current <u>and</u> future markets (EIM, EDAM, SPP Markets+)
- General clean-up of electricity
 rule sections
- Allows market operators to put in place key data infrastructure for WA cap and invest program
