<b>Purpose:</b> Ecology adopted updates to Chapter 173-443 WAC, the Hydrofluorocarbon (HFCs) and Other Fluorinated Greenhouse Gases rule. This rule supports the transition away from using some HFCs and similar gases in certain products such as aerosol propellants and foams, as well as in refrigeration and air conditioning equipment. These greenhouse gases can be thousands of times more powerful than carbon dioxide. By restricting the use of the most potent HFCs in new equipment and properly maintaining existing equipment that contains those HFCs, Washington will prevent roughly four million metric tons of greenhouse gas emissions each year by 2035.
Ecology amended parts of the rule to improve clarity, facilitate more consistent implementation, and reduce unintended impacts on businesses. Specifically, Ecology adopted amendments to existing sell-through provisions in <u>WAC 173-443-065</u> and <u>-075</u> , which allow equipment with prohibited refrigerants that were manufactured before a certain date to be sold for a limited period of time after the prohibition effective dates in <u>WAC 173-443-040</u> , Tables 2 and 3.
Ecology also modified <u>WAC 173-443-040</u> to align the list of prohibited substances and effective dates for Automatic Commercial Ice Machines with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's Technology Transitions Rule adopted in October 2023.
Lastly, Ecology made necessary technical and administrative changes such as adding or amending definitions, fixing typos and
grammar issues and clarifying language where needed. These changes do not modify any substantive requirements in the rule.
