**Purpose:** This rule establishes reporting requirements for recipients of funding from the Climate Commitment Act (CCA) accounts so that Ecology can complete our required annual report to the state Legislature. These reporting requirements include those related to RCW 70A.65.230 regarding expenditures that benefit vulnerable populations within the boundaries of overburdened communities and those that are formally supported by a resolution of a Tribe. Additionally, the rule includes requirements for recipients to report on the quantity of greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions reductions expected to result from work funded by the CCA.

Describe any changes other than editing from proposed to adopted version: Ecology made edits to: 1) ensure that, for all expenditures, recipients report on whether they expect verifiable emissions reductions or other long-term impacts to emissions; 2) make it clear that direct and meaningful benefits that are expected to occur may be reported; 3) create more flexibility for agencies that voluntarily conduct ongoing tracking and monitoring; 4) make reporting on job quality and quantity optional for expenditures from all CCA accounts, rather than required for expenditures from a single account; and 5) align sections of the rule related to reporting on greenhouse gas emissions reductions.
